JEFF BETTEN ALSO JOINS COMPANY AS MANAGER OF PRODUCER ROSTER

In addition to the initial client signings, mthree has tapped Jeff Betten, General Manager at Pittsburgh-based record label Misra Records and manager of folk group Buffalo Rose, as the day-to-day manager dedicated to the producer roster.



Wayne Martin, mthree founder and principal. "I'm truly thrilled to extend what we do to include producers, starting with Zachary Jablow and Adam Clark. In addition, the support of Jeff Betten on our management team will be critical as we continue to carefully grow our roster of talent."

"I've spent the past ten years working at independent labels, and I love that it requires you to be passionate about the art that people create," said **Betten**. "Teaming up with Wayne to work with mthree's producer roster means I get to take that passion to another level with the people who are so critical to creating these great songs and recordings."

Zachary Jablow is a former Governor for the Chicago Chapter of NARAS, and under the name The Professor, has produced such ground-breaking acts as Chance The Rapper, Saba, Sidewalk Chalk, Slum Village, Vic Mensa, Curren\$y, Mac Miller, and Ab Soul. Jablow has also been tapped to create soundtracks for successful advertising campaigns by brands including McDonalds, RedBull, and Coors Light. Jablow now owns and operates two recording studios in Nashville, HSC and The Hideout. Later this year, Jablow will release his first-ever artist project under the name Leav, with featured tracks from O.G. Maco, Cowboy Mugshot, and more.

Adam Clark is a 2011 Berklee College of Music graduate who recently turned from a career as a singer/songwriter to become a full-time producer specializing in independent rock and pop projects such as Cai Gray, Jon Car, Julie Elody, and Carment Pascucci.
